

Field Operator

Summary: Field Operator will be responsible for assisting in the maintenance and repair of the public infrastructure for sewer and water. Ensures that pumps, blowers, chlorinators, vacuum equipment and other water and wastewater treatment equipment are functioning properly. Monitors equipment for potential failures and makes repairs and adjustments as needed. Collects water samples for chemical analysis. Will also be responsible for the maintenance and repair of the Districts wells and tanks. Field Operator reads meters on a monthly basis and works closely with the Field Operations Technician in maintaining and repairing all systems.

Salary Range: \$13.85-\$25

Classification: Hourly

Essential Job Functions:

- Performs inspections and operates water systems as required
- Assists in all potable and wastewater system maintenance, repairs, modifications, and extensions
- Discharges reuse wastewater as directed
- Collects sewer and water samples as needed
- Maintains and cleans the shop, backhoe, and company trucks
- Reads meters monthly
- Assists customers with parts purchases
- Keeps daily log of all task performed
- Reports to the Operations Planner
- On call when scheduled
- Takes on call phone, as needed
- Other duties as assigned
